Committee Goals for 2007 (what did the committee plan to accomplish in 2007): Liaison between WSSA and IWSS to organize the 2008 IWS Congress to be held in June, 2008 in Vancouver, BC, Canada.

Summary of Progress for 2007:

The IWSS Liaison Committee and the IWSS Science Committee had monthly teleconferences starting in July, 2007. A list of the things that were done and time lines are attached. As of January 15, 2008 there are over 400 abstracts submitted for the meeting. Approximately \$80,000 has been pledged by different companies and organizations to help support the IWSC. The local arrangement committee led by Dr. Robert Blackshaw has done an excellent job in working with the hotel and in setting up a series of tours for Wednesday, June 25, 2008.

What was the membership/committee involvement in committee activities? Members of WSSA were very active on this committee in helping organize the meeting in June.

If funds were requested, how much was requested and how much was actually spent? No funds were solicited but WSSA contributed \$10,000 to support graduate student attendance to the meeting.

The success of the IWSC 2008 will depend on the involvement of WSSA and other weed scientists throughout the world.
