2009 Annual Meeting in Albuquerque, NM

67 posters and 106 papers were presented at the 2009 meeting. The total attendance was 320 people, with 203 people attending only the WSWS meeting, 73 attending both the WSWS meeting and the special symposium (Biological Control of Invasive Plants), and 28 attending only the symposium; an additional 16 people attended the spouse program. 40 of the attendees were students.
