2011 Summary of Activities (through January 2012)

• What are the committee's goals for 2012?

Compare Regulations of the U.S. and other countries pertaining to the release of biological control agents. The objective is to develop recommendations for APHIS to consider in granting biological control agent releases into the environment.

• <u>List the committee's accomplishments (through January 2012):</u>

Conducted a survey of the WSSA membership with interest in the biological control of weeds to determine if there is interest in continuing the committee, and if so, who is willing to serve on it. It was determined that difficulties in getting release permits for biological control agents of weeds need to be overcome in order for the biological control community to have effective agents to control invasive weeds.
