#### Eligibility

Graduate students are eligible for this award up through the first WSSA annual meeting past their date of graduation. Any WSSA member who has won an outstanding service award is not eligible to receive another one for the subsequent three years. The nominator is not required to be a member of WSSA.

### Nomination Procedure

The nomination package should be emailed to the committee chair and must be complete and formatted as a single pdf file. A complete package consists of a nomination form, transcripts, nominator's letter and evaluation form, and three supporting letters and evaluation forms.

#### **Nomination Package**

#### I. Nomination Form

Nominee: Name, address, phone number and email address.

Nominator: Name, phone number and email address.

- 1. College degrees. (degree, college or university, date received or expected)
- 2. Academic standing.
- 3. Publications.

List of publications categorized as 1) Peer Reviewed and 2) Not Peer Reviewed.

- 4. Special honors or awards.
- 5. Memberships in professional and honor societies. Also list committee activities and offices held.
- 6. Thesis outline. Brief (up to 200 words) and progress to date.
- Statement of contribution to Weed Science.
  A 50- to 150-word statement written by the nominee describing how the nominee thinks he or she is and will be contributing to the discipline of weed science.
- 8. Additional Information.

Electronically scanned.

#### **III.** Nominator's Letter and Evaluation Form

If the nominator is also the administrative supervisor, an additional support letter from a colleague may be sent.

Electronic supporting letters and a completed Support of Nomination form from each of the following (please, select only one person from each category): a) a member of the student's advisory committee, c) fellow graduate student, d) weed scientist not from the nominee's university.
