Eligibility

Nominee must be a member of the WSSA and employed in private industry at the time of nomination. The nominee must be actively engaged in weed science activities and weed science should have been a major component on the nominee's job description during his/her career. Any WSSA member who has won an outstanding service award is not eligible to receive another one for the subsequent three years. The nominator is not required to be a member of WSSA.

Nomination Procedure

The nomination package should be emailed to the committee chair and must be complete and formatted as a single pdf file. A complete package consists of a nomination statement, supporting information in the format described below and letters of support. A resume from the nominee may be used in lieu of the supporting document if it contains all of the necessary information and is accompanied by a narrative supporting the nomination (1000 words or less) and the supporting letters. Additional supporting letters should be no longer than two pages. Unsuccessful nominations submitted will be reconsidered in subsequent years if updates of the nomination are submitted.
