2008 Summary of Activities

What were the committee's goals for 2008?

- 1) Review and publish high quality manuscripts
- 2) Speed up manuscript throughput (final decision time)
 - a. Copy in Editor on all reminders to Associate Editors (AEs) re overdue AE tasks
 - b. Editor to follow-up with AEs and have alternate AE assigned if necessary
- 3) Increase communication within the WT Editorial group during the year
- 4) Improve manuscript quality by discussing with AEs common problems during the year

List the committee's accomplishments in 2008:

Two numbers increased substantially in 2008: rejection rate (44%) and impact factor (0.86). Both of these statistics suggest scientific rigor and journal quality. AEs were more discriminating in their review decisions in 2008 than in any previous year. In terms of speeding up manuscript throughput, I was copied in on all reminders to AEs re overdue AE tasks; I often corresponded with AEs directly to determine problems and possible solutions. However, there is still much room for improvement in this area. Communication within the WT Editorial group was fairly consistent throughout the year.

In 2008, 175 manuscripts were submitted to Weed Technology (AllenPress website: "**Journal Summary Report**"). Manuscript types submitted were: Research (159), Note (8), Extension/Outreach (6), Review (1), and Teaching/Education (1). Manuscript rejection rate in 2008 was 44% (see chart below). Days from manuscript receipt to First and Final decision were 79 and 106 days, respectively.

Although there was a slight improvement in the time required to render a final decision on manuscripts, there is still room for significant improvements in that regard. I will continue to encourage Associate Editors to decrease their decision times.

In 2007, there were 2352 *Weed Technology* paper citations; the journal impact factor was 0.86. In 2006, there were 2136 *Weed Technology* paper citations; the journal impact factor was 0.63.

What information was posted on the WSSA website?

This year, "Ahead of Print" articles were posted on the website. The posting allows authors to cite articles with a DOI reference number as soon as they are accepted for publication. It also allows WSSA members to access the full articles before they are in print (general public can access abstracts).
