2011 Summary of Activities (through January 2012)

- What are the committee's goals for 2012? None. S72 was an ad hoc committee convened in August 2011 and charged (a) to work with David Krueger to develop a new design and layout for the WSSA web site; and (b) to develop a position description for a part-time Web Content Manager. These goals have been met as of December 2011.
- <u>List the committee</u>'s accomplishments (through January 2012): Members of the committee worked via conference calls and e-mail exchanges August-December 2011. We reviewed several prototype WSSA web site designs developed by David Krueger and suggested modifications to the design finally agreed on. David Krueger is now using this design to develop a new WSSA web site that will be ready for review by the WSSA Board of Directors in February 2012 and potential launch shortly thereafter.

The committee also discussed and drafted a position description for a part-time Web Content Manager. This has been forwarded to Mike Barrett for consideration at the February 2012 WSSA BOD meeting.
