- Committee goals

  - Potentially review materials being develop by the Council of Producers & Distributors of Agrotechnology (CPDA) for adjuvant certification related to spray droplet spectra and biological effect.
  - Identify the need for better herbicide label terminology for applications related to UAVs or sitespecific management such as 'see and spray'.
